



#### **Organizing Your Email**

- Most Gmail-ers just archive old email and then search for it. This is fine for 95% of your saved email.
- Gmail offers a unique "folder-like" mechanism for "grouping" saved emails


Gmail calls them Labels


### Before You Go and Make a Zillion Labels (Folders)

- Gmail comes from Google. And Google is great at searching. So use the search box!
- If there is even a **remote chance** you will read the email again just **Archive** it.
- You have oodles of free space and you will never run out. Trust me.

#### **Archiving Email**

Select the email and click the Archive button...






## These are Labels

#### Labels Are Flexible

Every email you get has at least one label applied to it: usually **Inbox** 


Emails can have more than one label

Select an email then choose the label from the label icon






#### **Email Automation with Filters**


Filters can automatically assign labels to emails Optionally:

- Delete



#### **Customizing Gmail with Labs**
